In Memorium



Roy Koehler, KB2WXV, was licensed as a Technician in 1996, and happily upgraded to General as soon as the Morse Code requirement was dropped. He was an ambassador for ham radio and an active KLARA member, serving for many years as President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Repeater Trustee. For decades, he coordinated volunteer communicator assignments for the WineGlass Marathon and the Wine Country Classic Boats Regatta in Hammondsport on Keuka Lake. He organized KLARA's involvement in the annual ARRL Field Day, bringing tools, extra radios, antennas, batteries, log books, dupe sheets, and road signs. Roy was a "go to" person at special event stations (Glenn Curtiss' birthday at the Glenn Curtiss Museum; the Geneseo Air Show, where he also volunteered by driving a passenger tram). He was happiest when helping others, and gave freely of his time and talents. Roy had a soft spot in his heart for the wives of silent keys, helping several local ham radio widows sell radio equipment.
