### **Old Business:**

#### **Boat Show: Jack Young reported**

1. Everything is on track
2. Bill Olmsted will transport WCCB trailers to Depot Park early Friday morning.
3. Regatta: Bernie Burns resigned as chair of the Regatta and Terry Holland will be acting chair for this year.
  - a. KLARA: all set for their role at the show.
  - b. Considering course changes for next year.
4. Dock assignments: Don Bartold has schematic up to date with the registrations.
5. Volunteers needed for launch ramp on Friday and Saturday to assist boaters with launching and loading their boats.
  - a. Friday – Don Bartold, Bill Olmsted and Kevin Issing
  - b. Saturday – Don Bartold, Mike Yonker, Denny Clark, John Heil and Bill Olmsted
6. Thursday, July 14, 2016 at 6 PM pack goodie bags at Patti and Jack's house. Patti will pick up the wine from Hunt Country.
7. Dock update: Denny Clark reported:
  - a. Thank you to Terry Holland for his donation of a winch.
  - b. Dock transition on schedule – initial supplier of floaters did not follow through so Craig McMinn found a supplier in Rochester. He will transport them on Tuesday, July 12 from Rochester to the storage location of the docks; assemble them Tuesday, July 12 and Wednesday, July 13. Cost of these floaters are more expensive, however, there is no shipping charges which will offset the higher expense
  - c. Denny Clark will send out an email to provide essential information for the Dock Committee.
