3. Regatta: Bernie Burns tendered his resignation as chairman. Terry Holland agreed to step in for this year and will contact Bernie for details needed to run event. Mike Yonkers will assist.
4. KLARA: WCCB will meet to discuss the process
5. Registration: Dick Newcomb reported that there are 15 boats registered. Encouraged members to bring and register their own boats.
6. Dock assignments: Don Bartold has worksheet designed for placement of boats.
7. Launch ramp duties: Friday, Saturday and Sunday
