## **POKER RUN REGATTA RULES AND REGULATION**

In the spirit of past Regattas, participants will still be able to boat at any speed that they choose. However, there will not be an official start or finish to this event. Following is what the course will be like including picking up a card at each location:

- Participants will depart Depot Park at the launch ramp with their 1<sup>st</sup> card and head east
- Next stop will be on the east side of Keuka Lake approximately 2 miles north & receive their 2<sup>nd</sup> card
- Next stop will be directly across the lake to Snug Harbor for their 3<sup>rd</sup> card
- Depart Snug harbor & head south past Depot Park and back to the east side location for the 4<sup>th</sup> card
- Next, head back across to Snug Harbor for the 5<sup>th</sup> card
- Head south to Depot Park for the big finish

There will be a mandatory drivers' meeting prior to the event on Sunday morning. Full details will be provided upon your check in for the event. Please insure that all safety equipment is on board for the event. A waiver for this event is required when registering.

### **Addendum to page 3 of Registration for judging purposes**

#### **ACBS Class Categories to be added to page 3 of the Registration Form:**

1. Historic up to 1918
2. Antique 1919 to 1942
3. Classic 1943 to 1975
4. Late Classic 1976 to 1992 can be fiberglass
5. Contemporary 1992 to 2017, wood

For a boat to be judged, it must be in the water under its own power. It should arrive at the dock under its own power unless there is no dock space and/or at the discretion of the chief judge. (as per ACBS judge system guidelines (rev. Feb. 2017).

#### **Types of boats to be added to page 3 of the Registration Form:**

1. Powered ... launch, runabout, utility (see below) \*\*
2. Non-powered
3. Cruisers and Commuters
4. Outboards and engines
5. Fiberglass and nonwood, inboard power
6. Nonwood outboard boat and motor
7. Nonwood nonpowered
8. Outboard boat and motor with steering
9. Outboard boat and motor without steering
10. Contemporary

#### **Please keep the following in mind when you register your boat:**

**\*\*Runabout versus Utility** - If the engine is under the deck, it's a runabout. If the engine is under a box it's a utility. Lyman called many of their boats runabouts. For judging purposes it's classified as a utility.

**Preserved versus restored**- Here's the information from the ACBS judging rules: ACBS defines preserved boats as those containing at least 60% of their original deck and topsides material and are constructed using the same methods and materials as the original. Bottom replacement is expected for the boat to be serviceable but the method of replacement must duplicate the original. The use of plywood as the inner bottom when not used by the original builder will cause the boat to be classified as restored.

The choice of bedding compound or sealant between the plies of the bottom is immaterial; any suitable material is acceptable in preserved and restored boats — bedding compound and canvas, "5200", epoxy or anything the restorer and owner select. Similarly, the use of plywood underlayment in decks or topsides will also result in the classification of the boat as restored. Boats with less than 60% of their original deck and topsides material or restored using non-traditional methods or materials are defined as restored.
